

Reporting Portal

The Q Corp Reporting Portal is an essential tool for medical groups, practices and administrators to track measures and performance outcomes that are important to both the financial vitality of their practice, as well as the health of their patients. Available at **no cost** to medical groups and primary care practices in Oregon, portal users can quickly customize dashboard visualizations and drill down into a suite of sophisticated reporting to proactively manage their patient panels, track performance against state and national benchmarks, identify quality improvement priorities, and monitor progress.



When I get reports a couple of times a week from one insurance company or another, or packets and packets telling me what to do, it's not useful. - Customizable data dashboard in addition to pre-configured comparison and trend reports for an attributed patient population
- Users can easily trend performance on a quality measure for a specific provider or clinic over time
- Drill down on each measure and generate action lists to proactively manage patient care
- Identify variation within and across clinics to identify best practices that can be spread
- Compare practice and provider scores to national benchmarks and the Oregon Achievable Benchmark of Care (ABC benchmark) – a measure of high quality care that is actually being attained by peers in the region
- Easily validate data and request corrections through the HIPAA compliant, secure portal
